Application Information

Eligibility Requirements: Volunteers must be graduate students or postdoctoral fellows in chemistry, geology, physics, biological sciences, biomedical engineering, mathematics, chemical engineering, environmental engineering, biomedical sciences, or environmental science enrolled at Vanderbilt University, Meharry Medical College, Tennessee State University, or Fisk University. The Volunteer Scientist-in-the Classroom Partnership is designed to accommodate volunteers with flexible schedules.

Time Commitment: The conditions of the program require volunteers to spend a minimum of *one full hour per month* in a 5th – 8th grade classroom providing direct assistance to an assigned science teacher. Volunteers are **required** to attend a two-hour orientation designed to address the specific needs of the volunteers and the partnership.
